Rationale Statement

- setting the ethos and culture of the Society
- fulfilling our obligations to members and all stakeholders.

OUR GUIDELINES

- Be present, listen and notice what is going on in the room (the words that people use, the tone they speak with, the body language they have and the reaction it causes in you).
- Be curious seek to understand other points of view through questions, check what you have heard and verify your assumptions before responding.
- Seek equity and equality in voice everyone's voice is to be heard with equal weight and strength.
- Speak honestly and own what you say speak from the position of 'l' (felt, thought, etc.) ... not 'you' (did, made, manipulated).
- Be open and responsive to options and alternatives seek unity,not separation.
